Learning Objectives

Students will be shown the skills necessary to tackle the majority of sock knitting patterns. They will come away with 2 mini knitted socks, one worked toe-up, and one worked cuff-down.

Specific techniques that will be taught during the workshop:

Toe-up sock knitting	How to seamlessly cast on at the toe	Judy's Magical Cast On
	How to work a short row heel	German Short Rows
	How to create a stretchy bind off	Jeny's Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off
Cuff-down sock knitting	How to start a stretchy cuff top	German Twisted Cast On
	How to work a heel flap and gusset	
	How to seamlessly graft the toe	Kitchener Stitch
Both socks	How to knit in the round	Magic Loop

Materials

Students will be provided with:

- All necessary equipment (knitting needles, darning needles, embroidery scissors) for the duration of the workshop. Attendees may bring their own equipment if they prefer.
- A mini skein to be used to make mini socks to take away at the end of the day.
- A photo tutorial booklet to take away at the end of the day.

Required Skills

Students must be able to knit and purl, count rows and stitches, work basic increases and decreases, being able to work in the round (any method) is preferred.

Class Size

8 - 10 students.

Additional Info

Students will have the opportunity to purchase RiverKnits sock yarn and Addi sock needles at the workshop, but there is no obligation.
